

Cultural and Historic Affairs Committee
Meeting Minutes
August 14, 2012

The Bethany Beach Cultural and Historic Affairs Committee held a meeting on Tuesday, August 14, 2012 at 1:00 p.m. in the Town Meeting Room, 214 Garfield Parkway, Bethany Beach, DE 19930.

Call to Order

Ms. Olmstead called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

Approval of Minutes from the July 11, 2012 Meeting

After a couple of amendments to the minutes, Ms. Farrar made a motion to approve the minutes dated July 11, 2012 as amended. Seconded by Ms. Young, the motion was unanimously approved.

Announcements

Ms. Olmstead reported that the "Periers Day" event on July 27th was very successful. She noted that Councilman, Mr. Joseph Healy, expressed his appreciation to the Committee for all of their hard work in planning this event.

Ms. Olmstead stated that Mr. Ray Disney assured her that the Oral History Project will be complete by Labor Day if the Committee finishes reviewing the remaining interviews that were conducted. Mr. Disney also downloaded pictures from the kiosk in the Museum to use for the Oral History DVD.

Discussion Regarding Appreciation Event at the Nature Center in September

Ms. Olmstead explained that the Town's annual Appreciation Event is usually held at the Mangos Restaurant, but this year it will be held at the Nature Center on September 30th from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. She continued that the decision was made years ago to name the Nature Trail the Baldwin Trail after Cal Baldwin. A plaque was also made for him a few years ago. The event to recognize Mr. Baldwin will be combined with the annual volunteer Appreciation Event.

The Committee discussed the guest list for the event, and Ms. Farrar has already created the invitation. Ms. Farrar made a suggestion to incorporate the parking instructions with the invitations, and the Committee agreed that this is a great idea.

The event will be catered by DiFebo's restaurant and there will be a tent set up. It will be a brief program with Mayor Tony McClenny making opening remarks on the Nature Center, followed

by Mayor Tony McClenny and Mr. Cal Baldwin speaking. Ms. Wode noted that Cal Baldwin can be asked if he would like to speak as well.

Ms. Farrar advised that the newspapers should be notified to advertise the event.
