

**Charter and Ordinance Review Committee**  
**Meeting Minutes**  
**April 16, 2015**

The Bethany Beach Charter and Ordinance Review Committee held a meeting on Thursday, April 16, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. in the Town Meeting Room.

Call to Order

Mr. Peterson called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Approval of Agenda

Ms. Forestieri made a motion to approve the agenda. The motion was seconded by Ms. Young and unanimously approved.

Approval of the Minutes from the February 19, 2015 Meeting

Review the Town of Fenwick Island and Town of Ocean City Lighting Codes

Mr. Peterson stated that the following items need to be completed:

- 1.) Review ways to write the ordinance on lighting.
- 2.) Draft an introductory paragraph for the ordinance.
- 3.) Create definitions to be included in the ordinance.
- 4.) Review sections of the Code that will need to be removed.

*Other Discussion*

Ms. Brigleb questioned if the residential parking issue that was brought to attention at a previous meeting is going to be addressed. Mr. Peterson explained that this issue is on hold as of right now.

Mr. Peterson announced that the trolley routes have changed, and the updated flyers are available in the Town Hall lobby.
